### **ABOUT SHE PITCH**

SHE Pitch is a unique opportunity for Frederick County female entrepreneurs, both in the idea stage and growth stage of their businesses to win money, resources and publicity and grow their company!

Implemented in 2021, SHE Pitch is an integral part of The Frederick County Chamber of Commerce's S.H.E. Week, a week of events celebrating the Strength, Heart and Equality of women.

SHE Pitch had over 50 competition entries in 2023. Ultimately, seven finalists competed in front of a panel of live judges vying for over \$10,000 in cash prizes.

#### **COMPETITION ELIGIBILITY & REQUIREMENTS**

#### Idea-Stage Businesses:

- Must be at least 51% woman-owned.
- Owner must be a resident of Frederick County; OR lease or own a physical business location in Frederick County.

#### **Growth-Stage Businesses:**

- Must be at least 51% woman-owned.
- Owner must lease or own a physical business address/location in Frederick County.
- Must be registered and in good standing in the state of Maryland.
- Must be at least two years old (Registered prior to March 1, 2021).
- Must have at least 24 months sales/revenue data and annual revenue must be less than \$5 million per year.
